DESCRIPTION

RATES IN U.S. DOLLARS

These fees include a Concert Performance, and a Dress Rehearsal on the evening prior to performance. For a second performance of the same repertoire and in the same venue, add 50% of performance fee.

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Paul Halley, Guest Conductor or as featured Guest Artist

\$3000 fee

Paul Halley, Solo Recital – organ (and piano) repertoire

\$3000 fee

Paul Halley and Instrumental Ensemble Repertoire – Keramion Trio

'Triptych' (Trio of piano, pipe organ, harpsichord)
Paul Halley and two associate keyboardists

'Angel On A Stone Wall' (piano/organ, drums/percussion, bass/guitar)
Paul Halley, Nick Halley, Jon Suters – Keramion Trio

(Larger ensemble of piano, drums, percussion, bass, guitar, organ)

\$8000 total

Paul Halley and themed choral repertoire, performed with resident choir

Paul Halley and five players - Keramion Ensemble Band

'Sound Over All Waters' or 'Missa Gaia/Earth Mass' concerts

\$4800 total

With Paul Halley, keyboards and bandleader, and Nick Halley, drums

Includes fee for extra rehearsal for Paul and Nick Halley to perform this concert with local players.

Add Keramion Ensemble Band for 'Sound Over All Waters' or 'Missa Gaia' show

Four additional players: bass, percussion, soprano sax, guitar \$3600 add'l

'Sound Over All Waters' or 'Missa Gaia' shows require a Sound Engineer and a Sound System. Please contact a Sound Engineer directly for a fee quote. Call us for recommendations. The Sound System may be rented locally per specifications of the Sound Engineer.

Paul Halley and Keramion Singers (Choir)

Directed by Paul Halley - Keramion (16 professional/semi-professional singers, organist) \$9600 total

Hotel accommodations, transportation, per diem for meals and incidentals are additional.

Payments

A deposit of 20% of the total fee is due upon the signing of the contract to secure the date with the Artists. An additional deposit of 30% of the total fee is due 90 days prior to the concert performance date. The remaining balance of 50% of the total fee must be received in the Pelagos office no later than the day of the concert performance. All deposits and fees shall be made payable in U.S. Funds to "Pelagos Inc."
