- Sunday May 7 4:00 p.m. **Festal Evensong Celebrating the Coronation of King Charles III** **4<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Easter**  
**Sung by the Cathedral Choir**  
This service features the music of British composers, including Parry's Coronation Anthem "I Was Glad", the Evening Canticles composed for St. Paul's Cathedral by Herbert Howells, and the "Festival Te Deum" by Benjamin Britten. Walton's "Crown Imperial" will conclude the service. We welcome The Honourable Arthur J. LeBlanc, Lieutenant Governor of Nova Scotia and Her Honour Mrs. Patsy LeBlanc to the Cathedral for this special commemoration.
- Sunday May 14 4:00 p.m. **Evensong & Investiture** **5<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Easter**  
**Sung by the Girls & Men of Capella Regalis**  
The Girls Choir will sing their first Evensong & Service of Investiture. All choristers who have been singing with the Girls Choir since the fall will be formally "invested" into Capella Regalis. All are invited to officially welcome the first generation of singers in the Girls Choir, which was formed this past September 2022 and is directed by Vanessa Halley.
